Dear Parent of Rising 6th Grader:

While we want our students to have an incredible summer, we also know that research reinforces what educators have long observed: that mastery of skills diminishes over the course of the summer months if those skills are not practiced. In an effort to enhance the retention of students' math skills through the summer and into the next school year, we ask your child to continue to practice math throughout the summer. Let's keep our kids sharp!

Participation in summer math is REQUIRED for all students in rising grades 3-8, including those new to the school for next year. Carefully read the instructions below. Please note that all summer math work must be completed by Tuesday, August 6th, and it will count as the student's first minor grade for the first quarter.

Summer Math Lessons Required for Rising 6th Graders (who were in non-honors math in 2023-24):

Mission 1 -- Lessons 5 – 9 (Topics B-D)

Mission 2 -- Lessons 19 – 23 (Topic F)

Mission 3 -- Lessons 1 - 14 (Topics A-D)

To login to Zearn on a tablet:

- 1. Download the Clever app from your device.
