Blackbaud - Please take a minute before school begins to log in to Blackbaud to update all contact information, including emergency contacts. It is important that anyone who picks up your child during the school day is listed in Blackbaud. We will be mailing blue letters later in July where students will find out their homeroom teachers. If you have moved in the past year, it's important we have your most updated address!

Extended Day Registration Registration for our extended day program is LIVE! Please log in to your Blackbaud account to complete registration. Registrations completed by July 25th will have all fees added to your August 1st tuition draft. Registrations completed on July 26th or later will be added to your September tuition payment. School Supplies - All school supplies for grades 3Y-5th grade were purchased through a supply fee that was collected with tuition this year.
